Launch Dates, Market Availability

The release with additional enhancements and maintenance work will launch globally to all markets on **October 18th 2016**. Any user visiting the Red App Centre Website after release date noted above will automatically see the enhancements and bug fixes noted below.

New Features Implemented

Enhancements

The enhancements introduced with this release are listed here.

Automatic Activation of Private Red Apps

This is a new option that has been added to the private app order process, called Automatic Activation Order. This new option saves time by allowing the agency to automatically activate a Private Red App for all of the EPRs in one or more PCCs when placing the order. Agencies can choose this new option, or they can place orders the way they do today, manually provisioning the apps within the SRW agency admin tool (AAT), by choosing the Manual Activation Order option.

Important note: After placing Automatic Activation Order, the Private Red App will be automatically provisioned and activated for users selected in that order. They will also receive automatic updates to subsequent versions of the private in the future.

Automatic Activation Orders do not require the Agency Admin to activate the Red App in the Sabre Red Workspace Agency Admin Tool.

Regionalized Content

While many of the apps in the Red App Centre are available globally, there are several which are not. In order to minimize confusion and make it easier for agency administrators to shop the apps available for their agency, we have introduced a new enhancement called Regionalized Content.

App sellers will now be updating their red app storefronts to reflect the countries where their app is available for ordering/use. Sellers will indicate if their app is available globally or select countries. This information will then be visible to Red App Centre users on each Red App page beneath pricing information and in a new tab called "Regional Availability". Once an agency administrator or buyer is logged into the Red App Centre, only those Red Apps available in his/her country will be shown in the Red App Directory. In case of a buyer is responsible for more than one PCC and these PCCs are in different countries, all Red Apps available in these countries will be shown. However, at the time of ordering, there will be a validation to see if ordered Red App is available to all PCCs in that order. If there are some PCCs in the order where the Red App is not available, the system will present an error message highlighting the PCCs that cannot get have the Red App.
